SPECIAL THICKNESS DOORS WITH STAVE LUMBER CORES

Due to a lack of available material and the inherent problems associated with stave lumber, such as telegraphing, warping and swelling, VT will no longer provide stave lumber cores for doors in any thickness other than 1-3/4".

If stave lumber core doors are requested in other thicknesses (such as 1-3/8", 2-1/4", etc.), particleboard cores will be bid. Particleboard is similar in weight, works well under general usage conditions, and is more cost effective.

Structural Composite Lumber, or SCL (also known as Timberstrand™ LSL), will not be offered on 1-3/8" doors due to the weight of the SCL material and the size of hardware typically used on 1-3/8" doors. SCL will also not be offered on doors greater than 1-3/4" thick due to stocking difficulties as well as added weight.

Note: All quotes will be qualified when a substitution is made. Written verification of particleboard core acceptance will be requested when order is placed if this information has not previously been received.
