Terracotta and clay-inspired color tones are gaining space in today's design world. These tones offer consumers warmth and modern elegance.







Warm Veins

Vertical tile lay ups as well as other creative ways to mix & match the tile lay-up is the new fun & eye catching trend homeowners are latching onto.





Eco-Friendly Materials

We expect to see many consumers using their backsplash as a way to add expression and vibrant vibes to their home. The most popular hues are sage green, ocean blue, and terracotta.





Mixed Materials In The Kitchen
